EXCURSION

In connection with the Celebration to Commemorate the Tricentennial Baptism of the First Micmac Indians

Indians themselves are entitled to second class tickets at half second-class fare. Delegates or the general public wishing to travel first-class will purchase first-class one-way tickets from the starting point to Campbellton obtaining from the issuing agent a standard certificate, which when properly filled in and signed by F. Pacifique, will be honored by the agent at Campbellton, for free return if there are ten or more delegates present at the convention. If less than ten they will be returned at half first-class fare.

So from Sydney to Campbellton Indians will pay one way, \$4.30, return the same, the general public 1st class, \$12.80, return free, complying with the above conditions.
