LA FRANCOPHONIE MONCTON SUMMIT

Canada and New Brunswick will host the 8th Summit in Moncton on September 3, 4 and 5, 1999. The main theme will be "youth" and the secondary themes will be the "economy" and "new technologies".

The Moncton Summit will be an opportunity for the 42 heads of state and government to discuss how *la Francophonie* could involve youth and have them participate more effectively in the democratic process. *La Francophonie* will seek to advance the future of young people in the new millennium by contributing to increased security; promoting the social and economic integration of young people by helping them master new technologies; and working to build a world for young people through programs in partnership with youth.

The Summit is expected to yield an action plan for cooperative projects between member nations.

Concurrent with the Summit, the following is also planned:

Francophone Business Forum, to provide an opportunity for Canadian companies to showcase their products and expertise and to make contact with foreign Francophone firms with a view to establishing partnerships

Mondial for Young Entrepreneurs, sponsored by the Government of Canada and *la Francophonie* to help young people benefit from the experience of established entrepreneurs and to forge business relationships.
