

sation, under the provisions of this Act, for such injuries, unless he elects to accept prior or subsequent to the injuries such compensation in lieu of the allowance payable under the provisions of the *Provident Fund Act*, section twelve, Class D, and gives notice in writing of such election both 5
to the management of the Railways and to the Provident Fund Board: Provided, however, that the dependents of any such employee who has been or is killed subsequently to the twenty-fourth day of May, 1918, and who has not elected to accept compensation under this Act as afore- 10
said, shall nevertheless be entitled to compensation under this Act as though such employee had so elected."
