The offertory has been devoted to the various funds of the Diocesan Church Society, Algoma, S. P. G., S. P. Christianity amongst the Jews, Yellow Fever Relief Fund, and to general purposes and current expenses. The assessment has been increased 20 per cent.

The permanent parishioners are under great obligations to the summer visitors and others for aid in maintaining

the services and in restoring the Church.

The moneys entrusted to the Incumbent came from Mrs. Finden and Mrs. Macdonell through an entertainment; from Mrs. Meredith, Mrs. Ward, Mrs. Sterry Hunt, Mr. Chesley and Mr. Dunbar for Sunday School books, &c.; from "penny lectures," sale of fancy articles, and surplice fees for prayer and hymn books with \$22 for the "Ross memorial" fund.

Mrs. Williams, Rev. C. Hamilton, Mrs. Edwin Jones, Mrs. Jarvis, Mrs. Morris, Mrs. Hodgson, Mr. LeClain and

Mr. Williston contributed various furnishings.

In the beginning of the year Mrs. Macnab, greatly admired by all who knew her, and lately Mrs. W. Hodgson, one of the oldest and most respected members of the con-

gregation, were called to rest.

There has been a very general desire on the part of the people to pay the annual rent (\$48) on the small house used as a Parsonage, and also to raise funds immediately for buying or building a Parsonage for the Mission. The collectors are Mr. J. Walker, Mr. J. A. Jarvis, and Mr. Jos. Unsworth.
