An Act for the better preservation of the Peace in the vicinity of Public Works.

FOR the preservation of the peace, and for the protection of the Preamble. lives, persons and property of Her Majesty's subjects, in the neighbourhood of public works on which large bodies of labourers are congregated and employed: Her Majesty, by and with the advice and 5 consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:

1. The Governor in Council may, as often as occasion requires, Proclamation declare by Proclamation that upon and after a day therein named, this may be issued, Act shall be in force in any place or places in Canada therein desigdeclaring this nated within the limits or in the vicinity whereof any Railway, Canal or to any place other public work is in progress of construction, or such places as are or places in in the vicinity of any such Canal or Railway or other work as afore-Canada. said, within which he deems it necessary that this Act should be in force, -and this Act shall, upon and after the day to be named in any 15 such Proclamation, take effect within the places designated in such Proclamation:

2. The Governor in Council may, in like manner, from time to time, May be revoked and again declare this Act to be no longer in force in any of such place or renewed. places; and may again from time declare the same to be in force therein.

- 3. But no such Proclamation shall have effect within the limits of . any City.
- 2. Upon and after the day to be fixed for such purpose in such Proclamation, no person employed upon or about any such Canal, Rail-Effect of Proclamation. way or other work as aforesaid, within the place or places in which 25 this Act is then in force, shall keep or have in his possession or under his care or control, within any such, place, any gun or other firearm, or air-gun or any part thereof, or any sword, sword blade, bayonet, pike, pikehead, spear, spearhead, dirk, dagger, or other instrument intended for cutting or stabbing, or any steel or metal knuckles, 30 or other deadly or dangerous weapon, under a penalty of not less than two dollars, nor more than four dollars for every such weapon found in his possession.
- 3. On or before the day appointed as aforesaid in such Procla-Delivery of mation, every person employed on or about the Canal, Railway or other arms. 35 work to which the same relates, shall bring and deliver up to some Commissioner or Officer to be appointed for the purposes of this Act, every such weapon in his possession, and shall obtain from such Commissioner or Officer a receipt for the same.
- 4. When this Act ceases to be in force within the place where any Return of the 40 weapon has been delivered and detained in pursuance thereof, or when same. the owner or person lawfully entitled to any such weapon satisfies the Commissioner that he is about to remove immediately from the limits within which this Act is at the time in force, the Commissioner may
