A BY-LAW to raise certain sums of money therein men-
tioned, in the Township of Raleigh, for the year 1862.

Passed August 11th, 1862.

Whereas by By-Law, by the Municipal Corporation of the
County of Kent, on the 14th day of June last, entitled a By-Law
to raise a sum of money to meet the current expenses of the
County of Kent for the year 1862, the Municipality of the Town-
ship of Raleigh is required to raise the sum of \$1944.87 cents,
as their proportion for said year, to be paid to the Treasurer of
the County, without any deduction, on or before the 31st day of
December, 1862.

Whereas the apportionment of the Legislative School Grant
for the Township of Raleigh, for the year 1862, amounts to \$352.
According to the instruction of the Clerk of the Corporation of
the County of Kent, the Municipality of the Township of
Raleigh, is required to levy at least an equal sum of money,
according to law, in such case made and provided.

Whereas it is necessary to raise the sum of \$654, to meet the
current expenses of the Corporation of the Township of Raleigh,
for the year 1862.

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Corporation of the
Township of Raleigh, under and by virtue of an Act, Cap. 54,
of the Consolidated Statutes of Upper Canada.

1. That there shall be raised, levied, assessed and collec-
ted upon all Rateable and Personal property in the Township of
Raleigh, the sum of or rate of Four and a-half Mills on every
Dollar thereof, for the aforesaid County purposes; the sum or
rate of One Mill on every Dollar thereof, for the aforesaid School
