

The Moving Picture Theatre.

Is the so-called moving picture theatre a benefit to the community? Are the educational, as some interested in the business claim?

The increase in the number of these alleged amusement resorts, not only in Toronto, but throughout the province, has been so rapid that the authorities may step in and strictly regulate.

Many clergymen and laymen, who made personal visits to the moving picture houses, have stated that in their opinion they are not conducive to the highest morality in the community.

Depending to a large extent on the patronage of children, and presenting questionable moral subjects in pictures, these houses leave on the young mind impressions that are many cases have led to crime. Police records show this to be a fact. Statistics prepared by officials who have enquired into the matter show that more harm has resulted from these places than from the houses where the most lurid of melodramas were presented a few years ago.

The small investment required, has lured many persons who have had no experience in furnishing amusement features, to embark in the moving picture business. The price of admission usually is from 5 to 10 cents, and in addition to exhibiting pictures, the management also undertakes to furnish theatrical or vaudeville attractions, the performers necessarily must be from the humblest ranks of the profession to be procured at the salary that can be paid at the price charged for admission. It is a matter of common knowledge that the inferior vaudeville artists usually indulge in vulgarity to make up for their lack of talent. Owing to the fact that the price of admission would not permit the employment of a better class of vaudeville performers, the actors have been recruited from the ranks of the amateurs, and many boys and girls afflicted with stage fever, have been enticed from school to become actors in picture show theatres.

It is a grave problem whether the morals of young girls booked on the picture show circuit are improved by their association with such actors.

Aside from the moral standpoint, there is the question of safety. In all auditoriums it has been the aim of those in authority to have exits sufficient to meet the requirements in case of panic. While the small houses are constructed with the number of exits required by the various municipalities, the question arises as to whether they are sufficient to meet the demands that might be made upon them. As these places are patronized principally by children, the chances are that in case of a panic in one of these theatres, the tax to capacity many little lives would be trampled out. Periodically we read of fires in these places, generally starting where the machine is installed. This in nearly all cases is located between the front exits; consequently, in case of trouble these doors would not be available for use.

Another point regarding these houses, and one which adjoining property owners are greatly interested in, is the fact that insurance rates are increased on all property in close proximity to a moving picture theatre showing that insurance companies recognize the increased risk.

Ald. Maguire some time ago introduced in council a motion to effect that permits for moving picture theatres should only be granted to places which are on the corners of streets. This was a move in the right direction and should have received the consideration on the part of the city fathers.

SELLING ON SUNDAY

Magistrate Dismisses Several Charges Against Local Retailers.

Six out of seven cases of alleged violations of the Lord's Day Act in the sale of cigars, candy, ice cream and soft drinks, were withdrawn in police court yesterday morning when Magistrate Denison expressed his entire disapproval of the weight and bearing of the evidence outlined by the crown. The cases were brought by the morality department, at the request of the attorney-general, who seeks to have the law uniformly administered throughout the province, and would therefore hear the dictum of the court of appeal.
