MACHINISTS IN TORONTO AGREE TO SETTLEMENT

Accept Offer of 48-Hour Week With 50 Hours' Pay—Return to Work.

TORONTO, July 28.—The machinists tonight accepted the employers' offer of a 48-hour week with 50 hours' pay, and 1,200 men will return to work in the morning in 50 shops. The loss in wages in twelve weeks was a million dollars, and the international paid \$560,000 in strike pay.

ACCIDENTAL DEATH VERDICT OF JURY AT GODERICH INQUEST

Coroner Hunter Presided at Inquiry Into Death of Harry Watson.

GODERICH, July 28.—The adjourned inquest to inquire into the cause of the death of Harry Watson, the town electrician, who was killed at Bisset's Creamery on Wednesday last, was held tonight in the town hall. Coroner Hunter presided.

The jury returned a verdict as follows: That the deceased came to his death from contact with a high tension wire on the farm of Bisset Bros. Dairy, in the Township of Colborne, and we believe his death was accidental, but we consider that more precautions should be taken to lessen the danger to men when working at such work as the deceased was doing, and that the engineer should see that his instructions to employees are carried out.

UNDERGROUND BUSH FIRE HAS BURNED FOR OVER A MONTH

WABASH, July 28.—Fire which started in Fred Wilson's bush a month ago from a pile of burning brush is still burning.

The flames creep steadily along the moss and underground growths, and at times the fire is very hot, and recently stooks of wheat nearby were endangered by the blaze.

Owing to the great drought, the fire is gaining headway underground, and considerable damage has already been caused.

Lightning recently set fire to a barn owned by Frank Huston at Thorncliffe, which was totally destroyed, and a young son in the barn was burned to death, and the season's hay crop in the barn was consumed.

STREET CAR MEN IN CHICAGO VOTE FOR A WALKOUT

CHICAGO, July 28.—Street car employees tonight voted to strike at 11 a.m. tomorrow after refusing to ratify an agreement reached early in the day between representatives of the employees and employers. The agreement, representatives of both parties had thought would result in a walkout of the men.

The walkout, which will affect both the surface and elevated employment, the transportation system of the city, except suburban lines.

The agreement which was refused at a meeting tonight of the employees would have given the men a wage of 56 cents an hour, their present wage being 48 cents; they would have had an eight-hour day and were to be paid time and a half overtime.

CONFESSES MURDER OF SIX-YEAR-OLD GIRL IN CHICAGO

CHICAGO, July 27.—Assistant Chief of Police Alcock announced today that Thomas Fitzgerald, janitor of a north side hotel, had confessed to the murder of Janet Wilkinson, 6-year-old daughter of a grocer, who has been missing since last Tuesday.

Fitzgerald told the police he strangled the child to death and buried the body underneath a coal pile in the basement of his home.

The janitor was arrested last Wednesday and until today strenuously denied any knowledge of the girl's whereabouts.

The wife of the self-confessed slayer had told the police earlier that she feared her husband was responsible for the disappearance of the little girl, for whom he had shown a perverted infatuation. She said her life with Fitzgerald had been long and trying to save him from the effects of his moral degeneracy.

MATTRESS FACTORY IN TORONTO IS BURNED; \$17,000 DAMAGE DONE

TORONTO, July 28.—Fire in the Marshall Venthine Mattress Company's building on West Market street, this evening did damage to the extent of about \$17,000. A number of girls were at work in the factory at the time, but all escaped without injury.

DECEASED FOR I. O. O. F. MEMBER LAST 35 YEARS

INGERSOLL, July 28.—Capt. Daniel C. Parker of Canton, Ingersoll, No. 19, will have conferred upon him the decoration of citizenship at Dundas Park, Hamilton, on Wednesday, August 6. He has been connected with the I. O. O. F. for 35 years.

SERGT. H. CHILD HOME.

Sergt. Harold Child, formerly of Ingersoll, has returned home after long service overseas in Egypt and France. He enlisted in 1915, and served with the Queen's University hospital unit of Kingston.

RAIN BRINGS RELIEF.

Vegetation generally was refreshed by a shower at an early hour this morning. The rain was very beneficial, although it was too late to bring relief to some of the crops. The drought has been unusually severe, and many citizens have reported that their gardens are literally drying up. In many cases tomato and potato vines are drying rapidly from the intense heat and drought.

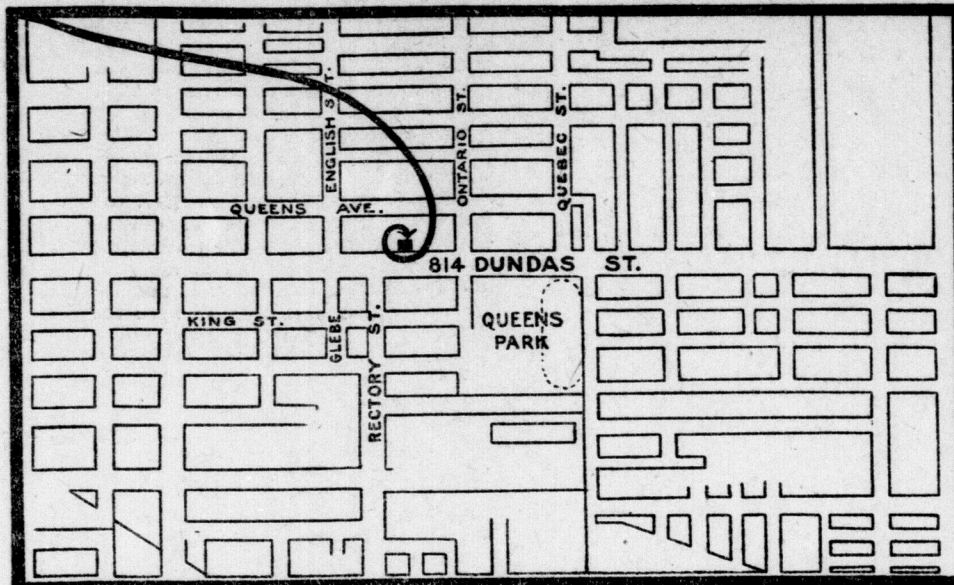
