AT OSGOODE HALL, The Actions by the Welshbac Incandescent Light Company - Judgment in Respect to Prohibition.

Mr. Justice Moss has given judgment on the motion by the plaintiff for security for the costs in the three actions brought by the Welshbac Incandescent Light Company, against Stannard, Mair and Christie. The defendants are appealing to the Court of Appeal from the judgment of the plaintiff.

Ground for Relief Must Be Stated. Since the arguments against Sunday cars have been scattered freely around the public are beginning to appreciate and understand the various reasons of the judges in passing this salutary rule of the court, which forbids anyone market, merely, without stating the grounds of it. The learned judge concludes by saying that "everything was conducted very loosely, and with a disregard of the plain directions of the act which is surprising." It is indeed surprising that the "cup which cheers" should have a bitter effect so contrary to the universal facts of history.

It is considered that the effect of the conducting of this election in the loose manner indicated is a hard blow to direct taxation. The result is a matter of the effect of the thin end of the wedge.

BLAZES YESTERDAY. Stewart's Planting Mill at Locknow and the Electric Light Plant Burned - Fires in Woodstock and Brantford.

Locknow, Ont., June 1.-At 4 o'clock this morning an alarm of fire was given. It was found that the large planing and saw mill and the electric factory belonging to Walter Stewart were on fire. The fire brigade was on hand as soon as could be, but the fire had gained such headway that it could do little but save the neighboring furniture factory and other buildings.

The loss to Mr. Stewart will be between \$12,000 and \$15,000. The electric light plant, which was located in the same building, is also a total loss. There is no insurance. How the fire started is unknown.

Blaze in Woodstock. Woodstock, Ont., June 1.-A fire broke out this morning in Samuel Higgins' frame carriage factory on Dundas-street. The loss was about \$20,000 in buildings and contents, which were insured for \$3700.

Morning Blaze in Brantford. Brantford, Ont., June 1.-At 3 o'clock this morning a fire broke out in E. W. Cameron's drug store, George-street. The stock is a total loss, insured for \$1500 in the Waterloo and Mercantile.

Five Children Burned to Death. Welch, W.Va., June 1.-Five children were burned to death in the residence of J. H. White, two miles from Keokuc, when a fire broke out at night. The cause of the family are believed to have fired the house.
