

BOGUS COUNT AND WIFE GET TWO YEAR TERM

Paris Jeweller Out

\$1,625 for Furs, \$250. for Corsets, Gubata Posed as Bourbon But Was a Former Dishwasher in New York Hotel and Married Widow With Several Children

New York, Dec. 19—An interesting indigent in the trial of the suit of Mrs. ta and his American wife, who were actured Blair Brokaw against her husband, cused of swindling Jeweller Fontana out of Paris, Dec. 19-The bogus Count Guba-

demned to two years imprisonment each and together to a fine of \$200.

This pair have had a remarkable career. The man, who called himself Count Carl di Gubata and said he was the son of the Archduke Othon of Austria, was formerly a dish washer at the Hotel Beauclaire in New York. and is a cook by trade. He is quite young, while his wife was the mother of seven children by her first husband.

Gubata's right name is Othmar Gubata and he was born at Scharding, in Upper Austria. He is alleged to have been mixed up in a number of swindles in New York and other cities, and in San Francisco possed as Count Eugene Harrach.

He has also at various times called himself Prince Charles of Bourbon and Archduke Albrecht of Austria. At another time he said he was the heir to the Bulgarian throne. At times he has been an actor and sailor.

The woman was a daughter or adopted

daughter of Baron de Thomsen, who amaessed a fortune in Brazil and was made a baron by the late Don Pedro. De Thompson afterward went to New York, where he died at the Hotel Buckingham in 1898, leaving \$1,000,000.

His daughter, who had married a man named Beck, contested his will. She was represented by Joseph H. Choate. The case was settled out of court and she received a large share of the estate. Prior to his death, Baron de Thomsen was engaged in the Brazilian trade and had offices in Wall street.

Beck, the woman's husband, died a few years after his father-in-law and in 1908, according to the general story, the woman married Gubata civilly in Zurich, Switzerland. His daughter, who had married a ma
