WEDNESDAY, July 4th.

In accordance with the 5th Article of the Constitution, the Synod of the Diocese of Fredericton met on this day, in Trinity Church School House, in the City of St. John, at 10 o'clock, a.m.

The Reverend Canon Brigstocke, Ecclesiastical Commissary, in the Chair.

Prayers.

After making some remarks, the Chairman informed the Synod that the Secretary, the Rev. Canon Medley, was absent from the Diocese in attendance upon the Metropolitan, and that therefore it would be necessary for the Synod to elect a Secretary for the present Session.

On motion of the Rev. Leo. A. Hoyt, seconded by the Rev. C. P. Hanington, the Rev. O. S. Newnham, Rector of Hampton, was elected Secretary for the present Session of the Synod.

The offer of the Chairman to act with the Secretary as a Committee to examine the certificates of the Lay Representatives was accepted.
