Synopsis of Canadian Northwest Land Regulations.

Any person who is the some nead of a family or any male over 18 years old, may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan, or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency for the district, Entry by proxy may be made at any agency, on certain conditions, by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sistered intending homesteader.

Duties.—Six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of threyears. A homesteader may live within nimmiles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres solely owned and occupied by him or by his father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister.

In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter section alongside his homestead. Price \$3.20 per acre. Duties—Must reside upon the homestead or pre-emption six months in each of six years from date of homestead entry (including the time required to earn homestead patent) and cultivate fifty acres extra.
