FARMER FOUND DEAD IN ROAD

William Hooper, an aged farmer of Lower West Beach, was found dead lying beside his horse and wagon on Saturday evening on the Black River road by Leonard J. Magee and Henry Appleby, both of this city. Magee and Appleby were en route to the home of William Evans at Bull's Lake to spend the week-end. Coroner F. L. Kenney was notified and gave permission for the removal of the body to Messrs. Brennan's undertaking rooms. From what can be learned the unfortunate man left his home on Thursday and came to the city. He evidently remained over-night for on Friday morning about 11 o'clock his wife was seen on his way home. It is believed that he was dead from 2 o'clock Friday afternoon. The body was lying across the road. The horse had become unhitched and the reins were caught in the dead man's feet. The body was considerably bruised as if by the horse's hoofs.
