LEGALIZED TORTURE.

THE HORRORS OF EXECUTION BY

ELECTRICITY.

PHILADELPHIA, Pa., June 27.—The

enforcement of the death penalty

by means of electrical cur-

rents would not only be agonizing

beyond conception, but would also

be a barbarous and cruel method

of execution, according to the

deliberate opinion of Myron Law, su-

perintendent of the electrical depart-

ment of the Philadelphia city.

He was talking yesterday of the

execution of the murderer Kem-

bley at the city prison.

Mr. Law proceeded to give some

interesting facts to demonstrate the

truth of the conclusion to which he

had arrived.

"Any person," said he, "who is

acquainted with an electric cur-

rent will not possibly have any other

idea than that it is a painful and

agonizing method of execution.

In the first place death by electric-

ity is not painless. Hanging, throat-cut-

ting, the guillotine, shooting, burning to

death in molten lead or in fumes of gas

are all more merciful than death by
