Memorial with full powers to act on the following proposals, viz:

1st. That his last photograph be enlarged and copies obtained, one to be presented to the Royal Military College and the other to Captain Mackay's father.

2nd. That a memorial brass be placed in some Church in Kingston, and that if the memorial takes this form, his father be asked to decide what Church it shall be placed in.

3rd. That in one of Miss Daniell's Soldiers Institutes a cubicle be founded and named after Captain Mackay.

4th. That should a philanthrophic object be decided on it should be in a charitable institute in Canada.

This Committee also to have power to receive subscriptions.—Carried.

An adjournment then took place for luncheon.
