Taking on Grain.

The S. S. Ellsler is finishing her cargo of grain at the C. N. R. elevators and will probably sail tomorrow for Havre, France.

Back From England.

The tug James S. Gregory, which went to England on the deck of the C. P. O. S. Valdura, arrived in port under her own steam from Montreal yesterday, after spending two years in the service of the British Admiralty.

Expected From England.

The tug Kitchener, which went overseas two years ago under her own steam and has been working under the British Admiralty, is expected back to work in the harbor this winter.

Came For Cargo.

The S. S. Ardgoil, a British tanker, arrived in port yesterday and will load grain here for the United Kingdom. Furness, Withy & Co. are the agents.

Avenmouth Service.

The Cunard Line will start a St. John-Avenmouth service soon, replacing the traffic between this port and Glasgow which has been diverted to Portland.

Ran Aground.

The Elder-Dempster liner Bana ran aground in a mud bank near the Tartar pier, Montreal, last Saturday, and is still stranded there. She was bound for a South African port and is slated to be put on the St. John-African route.

### AUCTION SALES.

Five properties, in the estate of J. W. Morrison were put up for auction at Chubb's corner by Auctioneer F. L. Potts Saturday morning. Two were sold and three were withdrawn.

Two houses on leasehold property, 42 and 44 Sheriff street, were sold to A. N. McLean for \$860, exclusive of a mortgage of \$200.

Two houses on leasehold property, 35 and 37 Sheriff street, were knocked down to Percy Steel for \$680. This property is also subject to a mortgage of \$400.
