

Then the main Question, so amended, being put;

Ordered, That the Bill be now re-committed to a Committee of the Whole House, with power to amend the same by adding thereto the following words: "provided that no such sale or lease shall prejudice or affect any right or privilege of any riparian owner"

The House accordingly resolved itself into the said Committee, and, after some time spent therein, Mr. Speaker resumed the Chair; and Mr. *Valin* reported, That the Committee had amended the Bill.

Ordered, That the Bill, as amended in the Committee, be now taken into consideration.

The House accordingly proceeded to take the Bill into consideration.

Ordered, That the Bill be now read the third time.

The Bill was accordingly read the third time.

Resolved, That the Bill, with the Amendment, do pass.

Ordered, That the Clerk do carry back the Bill to the Senate, and acquaint their Honours, That this House hath passed the same with an Amendment, to which they desire their concurrence.

The Order of the Day being read, for the third reading of the Bill respecting the Department of Marine and Fisheries;

Mr. *McLelan* moved, seconded by Mr. *Costigan*, and the Question being proposed, That the Bill be now read the third time;

Sir *Richard J. Cartwright* moved, in amendment to the Question, seconded by Mr. *Mackenzie*, That the word "now" be left out, and the words "this day six months," added at the end of the Question;

And the Question being put on the Amendment; the House divided: and the names being called for, they were taken down, as follow:—
