B. in 1843 in the Tp. of Gloucester, Co. of Carleton, and ed. at the Coll. of St. Joseph, Ottawa. M., 1st, Sophia Lafleur (she d.); 2nd, Miss Clara Caron. Is a lime and stone merchant and contractor. Has been Deputy Reeve and Reeve of the Tp. of Gloucester. First returned to Leg. Assem. g. e., 1886, and re-elected at g. e., 1890 and 1896. A Liberal.—*Cummings Bridge, P.O.*

ROSS, Hon. GEORGE WILLIAM, LL.D. (*West Middlesex*).
