An Act to amend the Act to incorporate the Canadian and European Telegraph Company.

WHEREAS, the Canadian and European Telegraph Company, have Preamble, represented by their petition the necessity of extending the time ³², ³³ V. c. 63. for the commencement and completion of laying down an Ocean Telegraph Cable from the North of Scotland to Canada, and of changing the name 5 and increase the capital stock of the company; and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:---

1. The time limited for the commencement of the work by the Act Time for comnearing and 10 incorporating the said Company for the connection of Europe and Canada, completing by a Telegraph Cable, shall be extended for a period of two years from the work. the passing of this Act, and the time for its completion shall also be extended to five years from the passing of this Act, notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the said Act of Incorporation as to the time 15 of commencement and completion of the said Telegraph.

2. The name of the Company shall, after the passing of this Act, be Name changed the "Canadian and Great Northern Telegraph Company," instead of the "Canadian and European Telegraph Company."

15 3. The capital of the said Company shall be four millions of dollars, Capital and may be increased by the Directors with the consent of a majority in increased. value of the shareholders: Provided, the capital stock shall at no time Proviso. exceed the sum of six millions of dollars.
