C A P. XLIX.

An Act to authorize His Majesty to permit, until the Twenty-fifth Day of *March* One thousand eight hundred and twelve, any Goods and Commodities to be imported into and exported from *Nova Scotia* and *New Brunswick*, in any Ship or Vessel whatsoever. [20th May 1809.]

**W**HEREAS by an Act passed in the Forty-seventh Year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, *An Act for permitting, until the Twenty-fifth Day of March One thousand eight hundred and nine, and from thence to the End of the then next Session of Parliament, the Importation of certain enumerated Articles into the British Colonies on the Continent of North America from the United States of America, and the Exportation of other enumerated Articles from the same Colonies to the said States*, it was enacted, that it should be lawful in any *British* Ship owned and navigated according to Law, or any Ship belonging to any of the Subjects of the United States of *America*, to import from the said States into such Ports as should be specially appointed for that Purpose by His Majesty, within the Province of *Nova Scotia* or *New Brunswick*, certain Articles enumerated in the said Act; and that it should be lawful in any such Ship to export from the said Port so to be appointed to the said United States, certain Articles in the said Act also enumerated, subject to certain Provisions and Regulations therein contained and provided: And whereas it is expedient to authorize the Importation to and Exportation from the
