A female photographer for the Ohio State U. student newspaper, the OSU Lantern, was barred from traveling on the team place to a recent out-of-town football game.

Although the incident has been called a "misunderstanding" by the athletic department and assurances have been given that the woman will get a seat in the future, student editors say they feel the discrimination was intentional.

Before the season began, The Lantern made arrangements with the athletic department to send one reporter and one photographer to road games aboard the team plane, which also carries representatives of other local news media. But when the paper told the athletic department the names of the representatives to be making the trip to the Minnesota game, the paper was hastily informed that the female photographer couldn't travel on the plane. The order, they were told, came from "the old man," which could only mean Head Coach Woody Hayes. A male photographer made the trip instead.

Several days after the game—and perhaps not entirely coincidentally with a federal judge's ruling that week that women reporters cannot be barred from conducting post-game interviews in the New York Yankees locker room—the Lantern was informed that in the future the paper could send females on the plane.




