## Grin and bare it

A female photographer for the Ohio State U. student newspaper, the OSU Lantern, was barred from traveling on the team plane to a recent out-of-town football game.

Although the incident has been called a "misunderstanding" by the athletic department and assurances have been given that the woman will get a seat in the future, student editors say they feel the discrimination was intentional.

Before the season began, The Lantern made arrangements with the athletic department to send one reporter and one photographer to road games aboard the team plane, which also carries representatives of other local news media. But when the paper told the athletic department the names of the representatives to be making the trip to the Minnesota game, the paper was hastily informed that the female photographer couldn't travel on the plane. The order, they were told, came from "the old man," which could only mean Head Coach Woody Hayes. A male photographer made the trip instead.

Several days after the game — and perhaps not entirely coincidentally with a federal judge's ruling that week that women reporters cannot be barred from conducting post-game interviews in the New York Yankees locker room — the Lantern was informed that in the future the paper could send females on the plane.

Eighty to 100 scholars from across Canada and the United States will convene at the Beaverbrook Hotel for the Tent Algonquian Conference, Oct 27-29.

The Algonquians are an Indian linguistic group, made up of tribes which have their roots in eastern Canada and northeastern United States.

The conference is interdisciplinary, and is expected to draw ethnologists, linguists, historians, folklorists, archaeologists, educators, physical anthropologists and museum personnel.

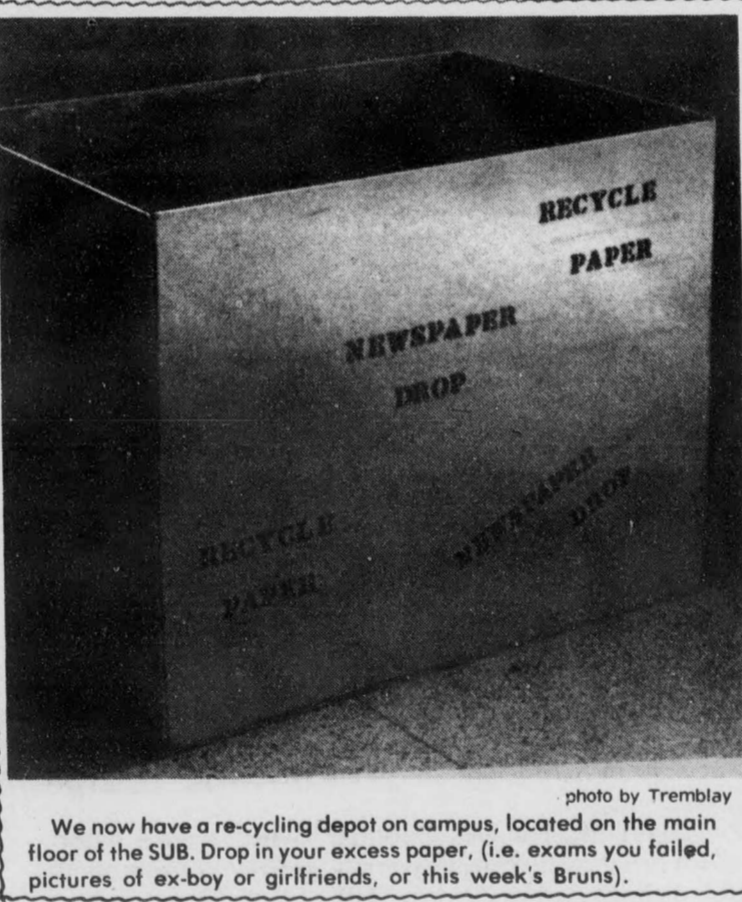
The UNB anthropology department is hosting the event, which is co-ordinated by faculty member Charles Ackerman and Vincer Erickson.

Papers presented by professor Ackerman, Erickson and Laszl Szabo, by recent UNB master degree recipient James Wherr and UNB alumna Gaby Pelletie will be included in the proceedings of the conference, to be published by Carleton University.

Interested persons are invited to attend the gathering. Registration will take place from 6-8 p.m. Thursday, and during the conference, at the Beaverbrook. The registration fee is \$5.

The Fredericton area was recently the site of meetings of native Indian religionists and the National Indian Brotherhood. The UNB anthropologists expect the current academic gathering to contribute to the city becoming a centre of interest in Indian matters in Canada.
