Indian Lands, at the River Credit and
the Salmon Fishing there: And I am
to signify His Honor's especial desire
that you take the most prompt &
energetic measures which the laws
will warrant, to punish those who
may be found infringing therein this
Aspect, and to prevent in future a
recurrence of the abuses stated by
Complained of by Colonel Claus. ~~to~~
