Mr. Peguemat will be able to get a good many signatures from among our friends in Waterloo. Perhaps, too, you would send me one or two additional forms which I could have on hand here.

I think it would be well for the Canadian Peace and Arbitration Society to take up the peace celebration between the United States and this country in some positive way, perhaps, first, by putting yourselves on record publicly in favour of the idea and then beginning a propaganda to enlist the sympathies of the Canadian public.

I notice that Mr. Neville and the society with which he is connected, are endeavouring to put themselves to the fore in this connection. His society, however, is established for the purpose of commemorating the heroes of war, and while
