Tariff:

Substantial reduction on: Implements and machinery of production. Articles of consumption.

Remission of Taxation:

Estimated that the reductions in taxation from 1926 to 1930 inclusive, meant a remission of \$116,000,000, which otherwise would have been paid in 1930, had former rates been maintained.
