
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NOTE: The area covered by this report has been extended to include the West Atlantic north of the equator and west of the eastern limit of the U.S. strategic area. This new boundary runs from the North Pole south on 10° W to 60° N thence on rhumb-line to 57° N 26°W. south on 26° W to 43° N West on 43° to 40° W south on 40° W to 20° N and thence by rhumb-line to the equator at 21°W. Positions of attacks are tabulated as follows:

(A) Canada-U.K. shipping lanco North of 40° North, East of coastal waters and West of theboundary of the U.S. strategic area.

- (B) Canadian coastal waters. The river and Gulf of St. Lawrence and the coastal waters of Canada and Newfoundland,
  - (C) U.S. Atlantic seaboard south of Canadian waters West of 65 W to 40 N and the rhumb-line joining 40 N 65 W and 25 N 80 W; north of Key West.
  - (D) Bermuda area. East of (C) between 25° and 40° N and West of 40°W.
  - (E) Caribbean and Gulf of Mexico South of U.S. south coast to Key West thence south of 25° N to 58°W. West of 58°W.
- (F) Trinidad area. East of 58°W between 0° and 25° N West of U.S. strategic area boundary. See sketch map.



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
