Q. And did you do anything further about it?

A. No, sir.

Q. Did you know you had the right to parade to a Superior Officer?

A. No. sir.

Q. You didn't know that you had that right?

A. No, sir.

A.

Q. You know it now?

A. I still don't know it, sir.

Q. Who owned the truck you were driving for this Maple Leaf outfit?

I owned it myself. I had a share in it.

Q. Where is this truck now?

A. I don't know, sir.

Q. Tell me Altenhofen, just exactly what was your share in that truck?

A. I got a share in driving it and I got a share in it.

Q. Altenhofen, it is necessary for you to be truthful to the Court. Don't try to hide anything or confuse yourself with answers which might effect the credibility of your answers. Did you actually have any investment in that truck?

A. I had no investment.

Q. In fact, was any part of that truck in your name?

A. No, sir.

Q. Isn't it a fact Altenhofen that another gentleman, entirely apart from yourself, owns that truck and you borrowed it from him?

A. I rented it from him, sir.

Q. Has that truck been returned to its owner?

A. Yes, sir.

Q. You said you spoke to some officers and N.C.Os. while you were absent from this centre. Did you know any of them?

A. Not by name, sir.
