Second Witness D57911 L/Hl Bouthillier B 807 Cdn Pro Coy, sworn states:-

I am L/Hl Bouthillier B, 807 Cdn Pro Coy, on the 29 September 44 at about 2300hrs I was detailed by Pt Crewshaw in company with Sgt Hovell to proceed to 14 Rue des Ballons Watteville and accompanied by the civilian police we discovered 35 full jerrycans of army petrol and 20 empty jerrycans and one barrel, full and one barrel approximately one quarter full, which we removed. We then proceeded to 85 Rue Saint Charles de la Madeleine where we found another barrel three quarter full, we removed this with the other petrol and reported
