ART. II. THAT there shall be a Prefident, two Vice Prefidents, a Treafurer, a Secretary, and fuch a numberof Stewards as may be deemed neceffary by the Society, who shall be chosen at the annual meeting : If any member, when elected, refuses to ferve in any of the above offices, shall pay. the following fines, to wit, Prefident, five shillings; Vice President, two shillings and fixpence; Treasurer, five shillings; Secretary, ten shillings; and Stewards, ten shillings each, current money, and then proceed to a fresh election, fubjected to the fame penalties, until fome one will ferve; but. fhould any of the members last in office be rechofen, and it may not be agreeable for them to continue, they shall not
