**Church Union Vote Of Congregation Is Null And Void**

In the Supreme Court Tuesday, in the Kennetcook Church Union case, a consent order for judgment was given by His Lordship Chief Justice Harris, and the plaintiffs were John White, James and George White, of Kennetcook, and the defendants named Rev. Gordon Robertson, John McCullough, Everett White, Tennyson Antony, Fred Roulston, Wentworth Forbes, Fred Scott, Benjamin Mackenzie, James McG. Antony and Edgar Antony. The issue was as to a vote on Church Union, plaintiffs claiming to have been deprived of such with the result that the poll was favorable to Church Union.

According to order Tuesday, upon reading the statement of claim and it appearing no defence was filed or delivered and upon hearing by court regarding what was alleged, it is declared:

That a certain vote taken by the members of the Presbyterian Church from 2nd April to 15th April, 1922 under the provision, is null and void.

That all proceedings taken by the congregation under the provisions of the Act are null, void and of no effect.

That plaintiffs were entitled to the said poll, and

That all members of the congregation in full communion were and are entitled to vote at all meetings of the congregation held under the provision of chap. 100 of the Statutes of Canada, 1924.

It is ordered that defendants, Rev. Gordon Robertson, John McCullough, Everett White and Tennyson Antony proceed to summon a meeting of the members of the congregation, under the provision sec. 8 of the Statutes of Canada, 1924, to determine whether said amalgamation shall enter the union of churches; that defendants pay plaintiffs their costs, so taxed, plaintiffs to have judgment for amount of said costs.

**Boy Will Live With a Bullet In His Brain**

Halifax, N. S., Oct. 26—Harold Hopkins, 16, Bedford youth, who was shot in the head by accidental discharge of a 22 calibre rifle last Wednesday, will live in spite of the fact that a piece of the bullet is lodged in his brain, according to the statement of physicians at the Victoria General Hospital last night. The bullet entered the boy's left eye and separated into three sections, two pieces remaining under the forehead and the third following the scalp around to the back of his head, where, according to physicians it lodged in the brain. For a time the boy's life was despaired of the location of the bullet making it impossible to operate, but he regained consciousness and last night was said to be recovering his normal health.
