GERMAN ADVANCE CHECKED.

BRUSSELS via LONDON. The following statement has been sued by the General staff. The position of German troops is hardly changed since Saturday. The advance guards are retreating under the irrepressible pressure of French troops, who are in considerable force over all the country South of the Meuse which they are clearing of German troops. Enemy's offensive movement has been ompletely stopped. The Russian peror telegraphed King Albert ongratulations, and best wishes for ontinued success of Belgian arms.

GERMANS LACK FOOD. PARIS, To-day.

An official announcement issued toay says confirmation has been reeived that Germans invading Belium are lacking provisions, having ndertaken to force the war into the untry without making adequate eparations. Isolated patrols are prrendering in order to obtain food.


