"The London and Middlesex His torical Society, in recording the death of Dr. Cl. T. Campbell desires to place on record the deep sense of its loss. He was our most outstanding member and was president from its beginning in 1901 until 1904. He contributed many valuable papers to its transactions, notably, The Founding of London, The Village of London, Pioneer Politicians, The Old Mechanics' Institute, etc. The mover and seconder of this resolution and Mrs. Gahan are now the only survivors of the first staff of officer

of the association. The society de-plores his loss and sinds sincere con-dolence to the bereaved widow." Mr. T. H. Purdom spoke briefly but feelingly of the loss which the city had sustained in the death of Dr Campbell, and paid eloquent tribute to his many good qualities.

A paper on the famous Anderson fugitive slave case of 1860, of pre-sent interest because of its similarity to the Bullock case, was pre-sented by Fred Landon. The details of this famous case showed the workings of the fugitive slave act and the attempt that was made to find a loophole in the Canadian law by which fugitives in this country might be rendered back to their own country. Mr. Landon pointed out the interesting fact that in this case there was an attempt by the English Canada and that this was fought by John A. Macdonald, later the firs premier of the Dominion. Mr. Andrew Stevenson of th Normal School presided.
