

Distress in Europe, as far as food grains are concerned, will disappear after the present harvest, according to John D. Shanahan, of the United States Grain Corporation, who arrived in New York Tuesday after an official tour of the grain-producing sections of Italy, the Balkans, Poland, Russia, Austria, Czecho-Slovakia, Germany, Belgium, Holland and Northern France. At least 90 per cent of the tillable acreage of Europe is planted. Mr. Shanahan declared, and despite a lack of fertilizers, and unfavorable season in some sections, this vast planted area will help drive away the "real distress" now existing abroad because of food shortages.

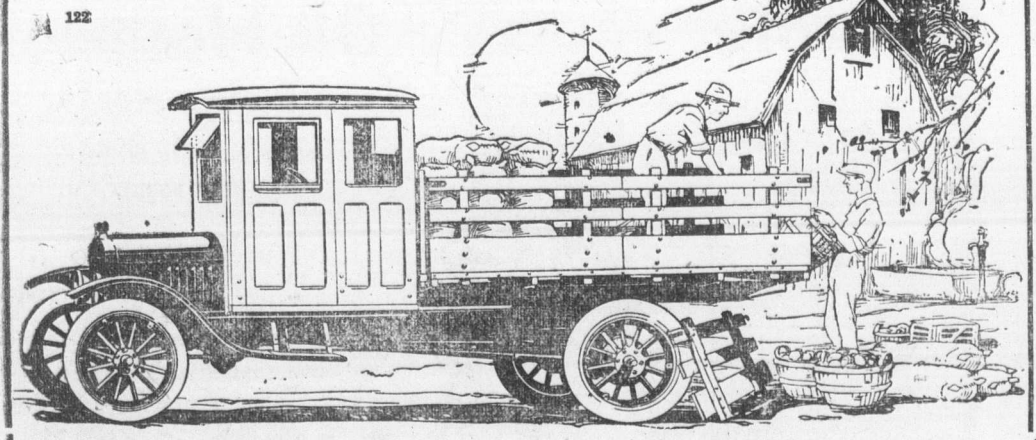
