About \$30,003 have aircady been expended in the purchase of land, and the construction of Roads, Bridges, and Buildings, &c. The debouche will be at a neck of land on the south side of Departure Bay, distant 5% miles to which place a railway is to be constructed. A company under the title of the Hasewood Railway Company has been formed for this purpose, and the Colonial Legislature has passed an Act granting certain privileges to the Company, amongst which are 10 acres of land at the site for the wharf and I acre at any place where a station may be made.

The Chief resident shareholders are now in Rugland making arrangements, with others interested for pushing forward the work. As it is generally known that Coal underlies nearly all that section of the Country, there are good grounds for feeling secure of good returns being ultimately received for any outlay in opening . . the mines.
