THE PROOF

Antiseptic: "Any substance having power to prevent or destroy putrefaction, accomplished by the prevention or destruction of the causative such putrefaction" - Dunglison Medical Directory.

I have frequently subjected parts of the skin which had been covered with this dressing (Antiphlogistin) to bacterial examination and found that they contained remarkably few micro-organisms. Above all the secretory ducts of the sweat and seaceous glands contained few micro-organisms, although in the usual method of sterilizing the skin the secretory ducts are the most favorable recesses for the retention of bacteria.
