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### A PHOTO TRIP THROUGH THE CANADIAN ADIRONDACKS.

Among the routes for summer tourist travel, opened up comparatively recently and which deserves to be widely known, is the round trip of Quebec to Quebec via Lake St. John and the Saguenay River. The boast of the Que. and L. St. John Ry. Co. that for scenic grandeur it stands unrivalled in North America, is no idle one, and the trip offers great inducements to the artist as well as to the sportsman or mere pleasure seeker. I propose in the following article to describe briefly the route, and writing for the edification of the camera man principally, must preface the description by saying, at the out-set, that although a very fine series of views may be made without leaving the
