MY DEAR MINISTER,

I refer to your letter of September 29, 1952, in which you suggested that the provisions of the Agreement dated August 16, 1950, between the Government of New Zealand and the Government of Canada relating to Air Transport should be modified in the following way:—

“1 The airline designated by the Government.....

I am pleased to inform you that the Government of Canada is agreeable to the foregoing modification of the above-mentioned Agreement and regards your letter and my present reply as placing on record the agreement between our two Governments.
