

Also worthy of note is the active presence in Senegal of the International Development Research Centre (IDRC), another Canadian institution for development. The regional IDRC office for West and Central Africa is located in Dakar. Some 50 projects having a total value of \$7.0 million, concentrated mainly in agriculture, have been supported so far.
