The Department of External Affairs has been advised by the Legation of Italy that the time limit for filing Special Property Tax declarations on the part of Italian and foreign nationals who are owners of property in Italian territory valued at 3,000,000 lire or more, elapses on January 31, 1948. The Department has also been advised that a similar declaration is required in respect of property which, although it is valued at less than 3,000,000 lire, is in excess of 1,500,000 lire. The time limit for filing this latter declaration is extended to March 31, 1948.

It is suggested that all interested persons residing in Canada may wish to file their declarations at Italian Consulates, who will upon request, furnish the necessary forms and additional information. It should be emphasized that all communications in this matter should be addressed to the local Italian Consulate and not to the Department of External Affairs.
