- 1 May 7.—*Resuming adjourned Debate* upon the proposed motion of the Honorable Sir John A. Macdonald, that the Bill (No. 92) do pass, and that the title be “ An Act respecting Aliens and Naturalization.”
- 2 April 27.—*Third Reading* Bill (No. 28) An Act constituting the Department of Customs.—Hon. Mr. Tilley.
- 3 May 6.—*Third Reading* Bill (No. 57) An Act for the better security of the Crown and Government.—Hon. Sir John A. Macdonald.
