Monday, August 27th

EVENING.—Grand Military Tattoo and Reveille and Bivouac of Troops on the Yards in front of Mafeking. Music by the best military bands of the district, patriotic solos by Mr. Harold Jarvis, quartettes and choruses. Beautiful Fireworks, etc., surpassing anything ever presented on this continent. For this night only—no admission fee to Grand Stand.

Wednesday, August 29th

SCHOOL CHILDREN'S DAY.—All children under 16 admitted this day for 5 cents. Every department open from 8 a.m. till 10 p.m. Judging of all classes of Industrial Exhibits in competition. Fine Arts, Women's and Children's Work, Horticultural Exhibit, etc. All the special features will be given in front of the Grand Stand during the afternoon, and numerous attractions about the grounds. Trained Animal shows, Boys' and Girls' Bicycle Races, 2.50 Facing Race, etc. Music by the Governor General's Body Guards and British Canadian Bands and the Imperial Hungarian Orchestra.

EVENING.—Beautiful illumination of the grounds. Great entertainment in front of the Grand Stand, and first presentation of the great Patriotic Military-Pyrotechnical spectacles "The Siege and Relief of Mafeking" and "Soldiers of the Queen," with magnificent display of Fireworks. Orchestral and Military Band Concerts, etc.

Thursday, August 30th

PIONEERS AND HISTORICAL DAY.—Under the auspices of the Pioneer and Historical Societies of the Province. Reunion, assembly and exhibits at the Pioneers' Log Cabins. The grounds and all exhibits, including the grand display of Live Stock, open from 8 a.m. till 10 p.m. Great entertainment in front of the Grand Stand during the afternoon, and many special features about the grounds. 2.50 Trotting Race and Open Trot or Pace on the large track. Patriotic Concert by the Boys' Brigade Band of Cobourg, Imperial Hungarian Orchestra, British Canadian Band, etc.

EVENING.—Complete programme in front of the Grand Stand. Grand Military Battle "The Siege and Relief of Mafeking," "Soldiers of the Queen," and magnificent Firework displays. Beautiful illumination of grounds and buildings, band concerts, etc.

Friday, August 31st

MANUFACTURERS' DAY.—Under the auspices and patronage of the Canadian Manufacturers' Association. All the attractions in front of the Grand Stand, champion stallion trot for valuable purse, trained animal exhibitions, and other interesting features about the grounds. Concerts by the Boys' Brigade Band of Cobourg, the Toronto Schools Cadet Band, British Canadian Band and Imperial Hungarian Orchestra, etc., etc.

EVENING.—Beautiful illumination of grounds and buildings, all departments open till 10 p.m. Great entertainment in front of Grand Stand; the interesting battle spectacle "The Siege and Relief of Mafeking," "Soldiers of the Queen," great programme of Fireworks, band concerts, etc.
