Quite a Percentage of Receipts  
Were Stockers and Feeders  
Yesterday.

The receipts of live stock at the Union Stock Yard, Tuesday, numbered 34 cars, including 846 cattle, 204 calves, 1425 hogs, 1539 sheep and lambs and 209 horses.

Butchers' cattle: Good to choice butchers were scarce and sold firm Monday's slight advance; the other classes were practically no different. There was practically no difference between the two days.

Choice heavy steers at \$7.75 to \$8.00; good at \$6.40 to \$7.75; medium at \$5.50 to \$6.40; common at \$4.50 to \$5.50; choice hogs at \$4.50 to \$5.50; good at \$3.50 to \$4.50; common at \$2.50 to \$3.50.

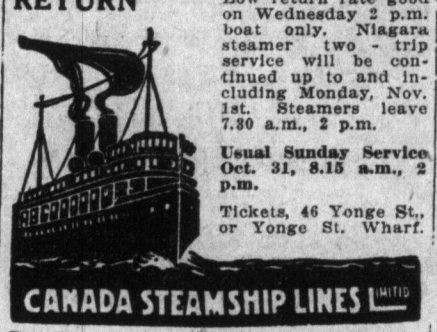
