more active members, setting forth the purpose of such meeting. The club shall act on no other business at that meeting.

SEC. 5. Thirteen members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.

ARTICLE XV.

Outside performance for the benefit of a religious institution, or for the personal benefit of an individual or individuals.

ARTICLE XVI.

Vacancies. Any vacancy which may occur during the year in the offices or committees may be filled at any regular business meeting, announcement of the vacancy having been posted for at least two weeks previously.

ARTICLE XVII.

Amendments and suspensions.

These by-laws can be amended or suspended only at a special meeting called for the purpose, and by a vote of three-fourths of the members present. The proposed amendment or suspension must be presented in writing to the secretary, and posted in the club-room not less than two weeks

before it is considered.
