deprecate delay and procrastination; it is to beg that whatever you resolve, for war or conciliation, may be includiately resolved. The time is mitical and precarious; the scene fickle and shifting; a moment gained may be your salvation; a moment lost, your ruin. A deseat at sea; a disaster in America; the accession of new enemies, (not an impossible event) I doubt, may disable you from making war or peace. Even while we are debating, important and precious moments are stealing away,

Dum loquimur fugerit invida Ætas, carpe diem quam minimum credule postero.

- "That leave be given to bring in a Bill
- " for quieting the troubles now reigning in
- " the British Colonies in America, and for
- " enabling his Majesty to appoint Commis-
- " fioners, with full powers to treat, and
- " conclude upon terms of conciliation with
- " the faid Colonies."
