

CANYON CREEK IS VERY RICH

There Are Many Big Ledges and the Ores Are All Showing Good Values.

GREAT POSSIBILITIES FOR IT.

It is Within 30 Miles of Greenwood by the New Road to West Fork.

The wagon road from Boundary Creek to the West Fork country is being rapidly pushed forward. This road will bring Greenwood 30 miles nearer to a district which is only rivalled by Boundary Creek proper. So far as the outside world is concerned Canyon Creek is an unknown territory, but the prospector, who has examined the ground, uncovered the ledges, or cut through the iron caps—the samples—all of which have been sent to the assay office, and the results are all encouraging, and confident that the Canyon Creek country will yet astonish the mining world.

Canyon Creek is one of the numerous tributaries of Kettle River. It empties into the main river about 35 miles above the mouth of the latter. The Canyon Creek is a considerable distance. The mining camp runs back to Cedar Creek, another stream entering into the main river about eight miles below the area. It is a considerable one. The formation is quartz and granite, and the ledges are quartz, carrying high gold and copper values. A prospector, who has just returned from the district, has the following particulars regarding the claims, the work done and the values of the ores:

"Among the claims upon which a considerable amount of work has been done is the Robb-Hood, a crown-granted property, owned by J. E. Guttridge. There is a five-foot ledge of solid ore on the property. Assays average 115 copper values, and about 150 gold per ton. Adjoining the Robb-Hood is a claim owned by Madison & Co. It is a large iron cap and a ledge over 500 feet in ore. Assays run from 80 to 850. The ledge is owned by the same company. There is an eight-foot ledge on the property, running 8100, and assays as high as 800 have been secured. The development work consists of a 20-foot shaft and numerous open cuts. The Silver Star, owned by Peterson, has an immense iron capping, fully 60 feet wide. There is a 20-foot tunnel also in the Silver Star property, also numerous open cuts, all in ore. Assays from this property run from 80 to 850. The Gold Star, owned by the same company, has a ledge 20 feet wide between well defined walls. It carries high values in gold and silver. The property looks well. The Mayflower is owned by Robert Wood and William Miller of Greenwood. The ledge has been uncovered, exposing eight feet of solid ore and no less than a quantity of the ore being brought down to be thoroughly sampled. North of the Silver King, the Iron Duke, owned by Sullivan, Waddell and others. There is here a ledge 40 feet wide. An assessment of the property has been made. The property looks well. The Mayflower is owned by W. S. Fletcher of Greenwood. Considerable work has been done. The ore has been exposed, and no walls found. The Riverside is also owned by Mr. Peterson. The ledge was started on this property, the vein was only two feet wide, and it is believed to be a continuation of the vein of the Chateau, Iron King, Iron Duke and Mountain Queen. The Iron King group consists of the May Queen, Jewel and Golden Crown. The claims are owned by John Simpson and brother. Two assessments have been done. There is an 18-foot ledge, and assays as high as 1800 copper, and 120 gold per ton have been secured. There is a large showing in the Big Chief, owned by John Gray."

R. L. Patterson at Greenwood.
Boundary Creek Miner: R. L. Patterson, general manager for Miller & Richards, the well-known type founders of Toronto, is in Greenwood this week. Mr. Patterson has invested heavily in mining, and his made \$15,000 out of Cariboo stock in connection with the organization of the new company. He is interested in the Iron Duke, Escudor, Sailor and other well-known Camp McKinley properties. Mr. Patterson is also a shareholder in the Idaho Company, recently organized in Toronto, by J. E. Boss to purchase the Idaho claims in Greenwood Camp. Mr. Patterson was much impressed with the mining outlook in this section, and believes that Boundary Creek will shortly develop into the largest and richest mining district in the West. He was also pleased with the appearance of the city of Greenwood, and was so impressed with its importance as a mining and commercial centre that he was anxious that the Manufacturers' Life Association, of which he is a director, should have the opportunity of buying the city's debentures. Mr. Patterson left on Thursday for Roseburg, where he will be joined by Mr. Patterson, who is visiting in Spokane. They return home via the Crow's Nest Railway.

The Fighting Chance.
Rainy Lake Herald: C. Peterson, one of the promoters of the Fighting Chance gold mine, called at The Herald office on Tuesday. He came up from St. Paul and will leave on Friday for Mine Centre to look over the property of his company, which is situated about five miles from Mine Centre. Mr. Peterson claims that his company owns one of the largest gold-bearing ledges in the world, the gold running out freely, the lowest assay being \$7.20 and the highest \$32. Shafts and pits to the depth of 20 feet have been sunk across one-half the ledge.

Cuba Claim in Camp McKinley.
Boundary Creek Times: A gentleman on his way from Toronto to complete a deal for the Cuba claim in Camp McKinley. This property lies to the north and west of the Cariboo, and lies between the Cariboo No. 2 and the Teaser. There are two distinct leads running through it, and from work done it promises to be a winner. Mr. A. H. Rice of Hall, Rice & Co., secured an option on the Cuba claim from Camp McKinley. Mr. Hall, who is in Toronto, turned it over to parties there. Mr. Hall intends to remain in Toronto for a few months, and this affords the firm every facility for handling good properties.

Evening Star to Ship Ore.
Rossland Miner: The Evening Star management has decided to commence shipping ore to the smelter at once. The road from the mine to the track of the Columbia & Western Railway is now better developed. It is anticipated that this will be in good order by this evening, and to-morrow the movement of the ore will be commenced. There is considerable ore on the dump at the mine, and this will be added to that taken out of the mine. The Evening Star should have several hundred tons to its credit.

Mining Notes.
It is estimated no less than five stamp mills will be erected in Camp McKinley this year.

The Stewardman, in Fairview Camp, is improving daily. On the 175-foot level, ledge has widened out to 19 feet of solid quartz.

A representative of some Standard Oil millionaires is in the Sloan Lake country looking for bonanzas.

Plans are being prepared for the new Payne luncheon, which is to be the best mine building in the district. According to the plans it will be 140x24 feet, divided into 10 rooms of 14 feet square. Each room will be fitted up with steam heat and modern plumbing, and will have accommo-

dations for six men. It will be in every way a thoroughly comfortable and complete residence.
