

ANNUAL MEETING,

February 20th, 1884.

The Annual Meeting of the Evangelical Society of the Grande Ligne Mission was held this 20th day of February, at three o'clock p.m., in the Lecture Room of the French Baptist Church.

The President, Dr. W. N. Clarke, was absent, being now Professor in the Toronto Baptist College. In the absence of the President, G. B. Muir, Esq., was called to the Chair.

The Minutes of the previous Annual Meeting were read and accepted.
