

## MEMORANDUM.

The offer made for the water front  
mentioned in Mr Phipps letter of the 14<sup>th</sup> Oct.  
is at the rate of  $63\frac{1}{2}$  cts per foot, viz:  
3 chains = 8198 feet @  $63\frac{1}{2}$  cts per ft = \$525.01

There are only two water frontages sold in  
Shaftesbury - sale 3052 - 2 chains in length  
by 50 feet in width for \$25.00  
and sale 2535 $\frac{1}{2}$

175 in length by 73 feet wide at west end  
and 33 feet wide at east end for \$70.00  
The water frontages mentioned in another letter  
from Mr Phipps of 14<sup>th</sup> Oct. are only in  
possession of the proprietors therein named  
but no sales have been made of them yet,  
no money having been paid on account  
thereof -
