BEGGAR IN DIAMONDS SENT TO WORKHOUSE

Threatened an Importer Who Refused Alms and Sentenced to Six Months.

New York, April 12. — Magistrate Earl A. Smith sentenced William Kothe to six months in the workhouse for begging. Kothe, well dressed, wearing a diamond scarf pin and diamond rings, was accused by William J. Wilgas, living at the Plaza Hotel, an importer and exporter, of gaining access to him in his private office on lower Broadway Saturday morning on the plea that he had business to transact.

Wilgas told the magistrate that Kothe gave him the name of Frank Hauptman, and his appearance was so good that when he asked Wilgas for money he was surprised. When the importer refused, according to the story told in court, Kothe threatened him, and Wilgas called a policeman, who put the beggar under arrest. Kothe pleaded guilty, but told the magistrate that he was unable to work because of poor health.

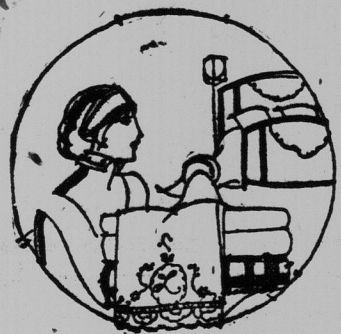

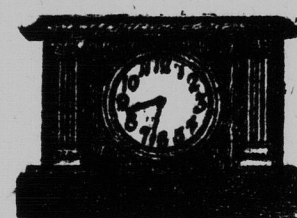

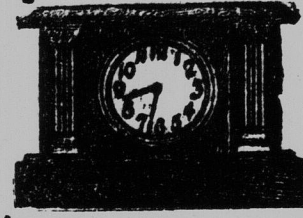
