Native Tribe Chief

Indicates Loyalty

Son of King Khama Pays Tribute.

London, May 17.—(By Mail)—"All chiefs who say they do not like the British are no more chiefs," said the first expression of loyalty to the British by the son of the famous "King" Khama, after his installation as chief of the native tribes of Bechuanaland. A solemn-faced native more than six feet tall, in a frock coat and top hat, surrounded by a bodyguard of dusky warriors in bright yellow uniforms and armed with old-pattern rifles—this was the central picture of a gathering of more than 4,000 men in the native town of Maseru, where the ceremony took place. The gathering, which included all the headmen of this extensive territory, was composed exclusively of men; even the chief's wife and children were not allowed to be present. Sekgoma was welcomed by the Chief Commissioner who recalled the merits of Khama and expressed the hope that his son would follow his excellent example. Messages were read from Prince Arthur of Connaught, Governor-General of the Union of South Africa, conveying the King's best wishes. The 4,000 natives then yelled their loyal greetings in unison.

BRITISH PRISON REFORM

PLANS PROGRESS RAPIDLY

"Trying to Abolish Everything, Gradually in Institutions," Says Commissioner.

London, May 10.—(By Mail)—"We are trying to abolish everything, gradually in prisons," said M. L. Walker, chairman of the prison commissioners, speaking at Hull says: "The London Daily Mail" correspondent. They were inaugurating schemes, he stated, whereby they would have adult education for practically the whole of the prisoners in the country. Amongst the innovations which he mentioned is one that shelves should be provided for books and photographs of relatives and "respectable friends," also the abolition of ugly clothing for prisoners and the substitution of simple dark gray suits of a similar cut to those worn in every day life. Other innovations are to be: New furniture of a simple kind, with a washstand and looking glass, for every prisoner. Facilities for frequent shaving and hair to be cut the usual civilian length instead of cropped. Increased frequency of communication between prisoners and friends. Some prisoners allowed to eat their meals together. Physical and other exercises in place of walking round the prison in a ring. Aluminium and stoneware utensils in place of iron.

Some time before the first of September the Soldier Settlement Board will bring twenty-two retired officers of the Imperial Indian Army and Maritime Provinces to take up farming in the Annapolis Valley. Most of them are well to do and many have good pensions as well. They will be aided by the board in every possible way, including the cheaper purchase of equipment.
