Hamburg, Feb. 24.—(By Mail).—A lot of perfectly good noctiluca, a sort of salt water "lightning bug" which is one of the commonest causes of phosphoresence in the sea, have been captured alive by Professor Kurt Hamdorf, of Hamburg. Cooped up in a bottle and taken into a dark room, they glow just like fire flies and glow worms.

It was only after several months of patient endeavor that Prof. Hamdorf succeeded in capturing the noctiluca in the North Sea.


